

Nickle Dickle 3-Point Shootout and Slam Dunk Contest

Rules and Procedures for Participants

Welcome, and congratulations on being selected to participate in the Nickle Dickle 3-Point Shootout and Slam Dunk Contest!

Approximate Schedule for Saturday Evening:

- **5:30 PM:** Athlete arrival — check-in, get shirt, socialize.
There is a private area for players with food, restrooms, and a place to store your belongings. Youth players will be available to rebound for you during warm-ups.
 - **5:45 PM:** Doors open for spectators (\$5 admission)
 - **6:15 PM:** Official start — National Anthem, followed by youth shooting competition
 - **6:30 PM:** Girls' 3-Point Shootout
 - **6:50 PM:** Boys' 3-Point Shootout
 - **7:10 PM:** Slam Dunk Contest

What Should I Wear?

The only stipulation is that athletes **should not wear a school-provided uniform**, since this is not a formal MSHSL event.

Many participants wear a high school t-shirt, an AAU shirt, or a future college shirt.

Each player will receive a Nickle Dickle shooting shirt. You are welcome (but not required) to wear it.

Be comfortable — wear what you want!

3-Point Shootout Rules:

- The contest includes **5 shots at 5 stations** (corner, wing, top of key, wing, corner) — **25 shots total**.
 - The fifth ball at each station is a **bonus ball worth 2 points**.
 - **Maximum possible score: 30 points**.
 - Balls will be handed to shooters — **no ball racks**.
 - You will have **85 seconds** to complete your shots.
(This timing allows a comfortable, non-rushed pace.)
 - The field typically includes **8–12 participants**.
The **top 4–6 shooters** will advance to a second (final) round, starting with a clean slate.

Slam Dunk Contest Rules:

- Dunks are judged by **five judges**.
 - Each judge scores each dunk from **5 to 10 points**.
 - **Maximum dunk score: 50 points**; minimum score: 25 points.
 - If a dunk is missed, a **45-second clock** starts. Players have this time to successfully complete the dunk.
 - Each contestant gets **two dunks** in the first round; the scores are added together.
 - The **top dunkers** will advance to the final round (starting fresh) and have an opportunity for **two more dunks**.
 - Players eliminated after Round 1 will be invited to perform an **unjudged farewell dunk**.
